

**4 V. S. A. § 25. JUDICIAL BRANCH; FURLOUGH DAYS;  
ADMINISTRATIVE  
LEAVE**

(a) The supreme court is authorized to declare up to 12 unpaid judicial branch furlough days in a fiscal year and on those days may close courts in the state. For purposes of implementing a furlough day, the supreme court is authorized to reduce on a daily or hourly basis all salaries established by 32 V.S.A. §§ 1003(c), 1141, 1142, and 1181, and all other salaries paid by the judicial branch. Furlough days declared under this section shall have the same effect as holidays under 1 V.S.A. § 371 for the purpose of counting time under the rules of court procedure and the Vermont Statutes Annotated.
